As an affiliated society of the RHS, we get a free group entry to one of their gardens each year and, as we went to Hyde Hall last year in the hot summer sun, and this year we will visit Hyde Hall in the summer.

The visit is booked for 8 August 2020 to coincide with their Summer Flower Show & Plant Fair, which is now a well-established event. There are many stalls selling both plants and garden sundries, together with a good range of outlets for food and drink.

Manual wheelchairs are available free of charge. Hyde Hall also has two powered mobility scooters that can be hired for a suggested donation of £2, but please call 01245 402019 well in advance to reserve one for your visit. There is a mobility vehicle that provides a shuttle service from the Welcome Building to the Hilltop Garden.

This will be a single destination visit, and the cost of £16.00 each is based on the charge for the coach only, as there is no entry fee for the group. Friends and family are more than welcome.

We plan to leave Marshalswick Library at 9.00am to arrive at Hyde Hall for about 10.00am. We will leave at 4.00pm, which should get us back to St Albans by approx 5.15pm, depending on the traffic.
